Visa Specific Instructions for Vietnam

Everything required in the generic Document Checklist for Temporary Resident Visa (IMM5484) must be included with your application, when applicable.

Failure to submit all required documentation may result in the refusal of your application or processing delays.

The following instructions provide additional information to prepare your application. Whether you apply on-line or through a paper application, the requirements are the same.

Global CAN+ program	
If you have travelled to Canada in the last ten (10) years or currently hold a valid United States non-immigrant visa and can provide proof (entry stamps in passport, US valid visa), no proof of financial support is needed.	
For all others, provide proof of financial support to cover the expenses for the duration of your visit:	
 Copies of bank statements or bank book covering the past three months. Any additional relevant documentation (employment letter, pay slips, proof of pension, business registration, investments, etc.) 	
If you are not paying for your own trip:	
 Provide a letter signed by the person paying and a photocopy of their passport, or other official identification with photo and a bank certificate proving that they have sufficient funds. Describe how this person is related to you. These documents must be dated within three months of the date on which the application is submitted. 	

You must submit the following items	
 Passport Valid passport; Include all cancelled or expired passports, if available. 	
 Travel History Copy of previous Canadian visa, Valid or past USA visas, visas for other countries, entry and exit stamps. 	
Purpose of your travel to Canada • For tourism: Travel itinerary • For visit to family or friend: Letter of invitation • For other purpose (Business, etc.): Letter of explanation	

• Minors travelling alone must carry information concerning the person who will be responsible. If the child is the subject of a custody order or is travelling with one parent, proof of custody or the other parent's consent for the trip must also be provided. It is recommended that minors travelling without their parents have a letter of permission to travel from the non-accompanying parent(s).

If applicable, you must also submit:	
 For Short-term studies (short program, one term exchange or summer school): Letter of Acceptance from the Admissions or Registrar's Office of a Canadian school showing the exact amount of tuition fees the applicant is required to pay, the anticipated start and end dates, and the latest date by which the applicant may register 	
If you are a returning student with valid study permit: Copy of valid Canadian Study Permit	
If you are a returning worker holding a valid work permit:Copy of valid Canadian Work Permit	
 If you are applying for a transit visa: Copy of your air ticket and travel itinerary. Indicate the number of times you will be entering Canada and the dates and times for each entry and exit. A valid visa for country of final destination 	
Family Information Form IMM 5707, fully completed, dated and signed.	

Note: the submission of an application with the documents listed below does not guarantee the issuance of a visa. The migration officer may also request additional documents before a decision is taken.
