Application for a study permit in Vietnam

This application kit contains instructions to apply for a study permit at all levels.

Note: As of April 30th 2019, study permit applications submitted through the Student Direct Stream **must** be submitted online. If you were accepted to study at a post-secondary school in Canada, find out how you can [get your study permit through the Student Direct Stream](#) on our website.

Study permit checklist

- This checklist should be used in conjunction with the [IMM 5483](#) Document Checklist for a Study Permit
- Any document not in English or French must be accompanied by a certified translation.
- Failure to submit all required documentation may result in the refusal of your application or delay processing.
- False statements or submission of fraudulent documents will result in refusal.
- A [medical exam](#) is required for study program exceeding 6 months. Study permit applicants can undergo up-front medical examinations.
- We strongly recommend that you submit your application at least three months ahead of your proposed date of travel.
- When submitting your completed and signed application form, be sure to include the barcode (last) page.

Photocopy of your most recent diploma or school certificate and your most recent mark sheets.	<input type="checkbox"/>
Letter of Acceptance from a Canadian Institution. The letter must show the program title, level of study, anticipated start and finish dates, the latest date you may register and the exact amount of tuition fees you are required to pay.	<input type="checkbox"/>
Certificat d'acceptation du Québec (CAQ) if you are studying in an educational institution in Quebec.	<input type="checkbox"/>
Police Certificate. Applicants more than 18 years old must provide a Police Certificate. (Phiếu Lý Lịch Tư Pháp Số 2)	<input type="checkbox"/>
Medical Examination. You may undergo a medical examination before submitting your Study Permit application (ensure to attach a copy of the form given to you by the doctor) or wait for the request to be sent from our office.	<input type="checkbox"/>

<p>Proof of funds may take the following forms:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • evidence that the tuition fees have already been paid for your first year of studies; • Certificates of Deposit, dated within the last two months showing current funds available; • bank books; • evidence of your parents' income and employment: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ employment letters ○ business registration ○ tax receipts <p>If you are being supported by a person other than your parents or if you are employed and self-supporting your studies, the same information is required for them or for you.</p> <p>If you are receiving any funding from a school in Canada or other organization, submit the letter containing details of the funding you are to receive during each year of your proposed course of study.</p>	<input type="checkbox"/>
